THINGS ANIMALS	<p>Something: algo.</p> <p>- Affirmative: There 's something in the room. (hay algo en la habitación)</p> <p>- Interrogative (cuando se espera una respuesta afirmativa) Can I have something to eat? (¿puedo tomar algo de comer?)</p>	<p>Anything: nada, algo.</p> <p>- Negative: I didn't bring anything. (no traje nada)</p> <p>- Interrogative Is there anything on TV ? (¿ponen algo en la tele?)</p>
PLACE	<p>Somewhere: en algún lugar.</p> <p>- Affirmative: The bag must be somewhere. (hay algo en la habitación)</p>	<p>Anywhere:</p> <p>- Negative: en/a ningún sitio. I didn't go anywhere last night. (no fui a ningún sitio la noche pasada)</p> <p>- Interrogative : en/a algún sitio. Are they going anywhere today? (¿van a algún sitio hoy?)</p>
